PONDER POINT: GOD SPEAKS

Lydia and Philippi Acts 16:6–15 Paul spoke to Lydia and she responded to his message.

DID YOU KNOW?

Share these facts to get the conversation started.

- Paul's argument in the book of Galatians revolves around whether or not Gentiles can be accepted into the family of God without rst becoming Jews.
- Paul says that if you still believe that you must do outward, eshly things to be accounted a part of the family of God, you're still living in the era of the esh, and, as such, your actions will be eshly. You will exhibit the deeds that the esh motivates—sexual immorality, idolatry, hatred, and more (Galatians 5:19–21).
- Paul then says that if you recognize that as a believer in Jesus, you're now motivated and empowered by the Holy Spirit for Spirit-like living, then your actions will ow from that reality and you'll produce the fruit of the Spirit—love, joy, peace, and more (5:22–24).

CONNECT AS A FAMILY

This week, keep a few pieces of fruit nearby as you read this part of The Big God Story. Ask your children if they've ever seen how each piece of fruit grows on a tree or bush. Read **Galatians 5:13–25** together. We struggle against our sinful nature, but Jesus died to set us free from sin! God's Holy Spirit inside us renews us, making us more like Him. God's Spirit grows spiritual fruit in us. Share with your children a way God's Spirit has renewed you.

After reading the Scripture passage, discuss these questions together:

- What is the fruit of the Spirit?
- What are some ways you see the fruit of the Spirit in your family members?
- What are some signs of God's Spirit working inside of you?

These questions can easily extend into the rest of the week. Look for opportunities to bring conversations about how God's Spirit renews into your everyday life as a family.

REMEMBER VERSE

The Remember Verse focuses on a character trait of God that's highlighted in next week's portion of The Big God Story.

Now that one who has fashioned us for this very purpose is God, who has given us the Spirit as a depost, guaranteeing what is to come.

2 Corinthians 5:5

BLESSING

Blessings are often used in the Bible. A blessing can be a prayer of commission, a portion of Scripture, or words to encourage and guide.

A blessing to pray over your child:
